I told the students of my participation at the national level when at the SAMA annual meeting in Los Angeles, California in 1970, I was elected as the first Chairman of the newly formed Organization of Student Representatives (OSR) of the Association of American Medical Colleges (AAMC) which is the accrediting body of undergraduate and graduate medical education in the USA, along with the AMA Medical Education Committee.
